

Class of 2026 Farmersville High School Senior Checklist

Congratulations! You've made it to your senior year of high school! This will be a very busy time and it will be important that you stay on track. Let the following checklist help you navigate the demands of high school graduation and college planning.

Make sure you have done all of the following!

Farmersville:

- Take your senior picture. See Mr. Beckham if you still haven't done this.
- Take the TSI, if needed. See Ms. Matkin if you are unsure.
- Make sure you have ordered your cap & gown (www.balfour1.com)-early spring semester (January 25)-Balfour will be at FHS on Nov 6 for a Cap & Gown presentation
- All students are required to complete the FAFSA (or complete the opt out form) as a graduation requirement (opens Dec 1)

- Graduate and rule the world!

College:

- Sign up to take the SAT in March if you still need it. See Ms. Cooper if you are unsure.
- Apply to college(s) if you haven't done so. We recommend using ApplyTexas
- Request HS Transcripts to be sent to colleges (email Ms. Cooper).
- Physically or virtually visit the colleges you've selected. Seniors get 2 excused days to visit a college.
- Double check to make sure your college has received all required documents.
- Register with the NAIA and/or NCAA if you are planning to participate in sports in college.
- Farmersville ISD LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP begins!!! Ms. Cooper will send out application through Remind (typically early March)
- Inform all colleges of your acceptance or rejection of the offer of admission and/or financial aid by May 1.
- Send housing application and deposit.
- Sign up for an orientation meeting at the college of your choice. Sign up for an early one-good classes/professors go fast.
- Get the meningitis shot and send document to your college.
- Turn in all scholarships received to the counseling department.
